

WatsonMIDI™

Quick Start Guide

Get up and running in 5 minutes

WatsonMIDI lets you record, organize, and play back MIDI performances on your iPhone or iPad. This guide will help you make your first recording.

Step 1: Connect Your MIDI Device

For Bluetooth MIDI (Recommended):

- Ensure your Bluetooth MIDI adapter is powered and in pairing mode
- Open WatsonMIDI and go to **Settings** → **Scan for Devices**
- Tap your device name to connect (green dot = connected)

For Wired USB-MIDI:

- Connect your MIDI interface to your iPhone/iPad using appropriate adapter
- WatsonMIDI will detect the connection automatically

Step 2: Make Your First Recording

1. Go to the **Player** tab (bottom left)
2. Tap the red **Record** button
3. Play your instrument — the timer will show elapsed time
4. Tap **Stop** when finished
5. Enter a name for your recording and tap **Save**

Step 3: Organize Your Recordings

- **Library tab:** View all your recordings, search by title or hymn number
- **Folders:** Create folders (General, Christmas, Easter, etc.) to organize
- **Services tab:** Create playlists for specific worship services

Step 4: Play Back Your Recording

1. Find your recording in the **Library** or select a **Service**
2. Tap the **Play** button
3. Your connected MIDI device will play back the performance

■ **Tip:** Enable **Listening Mode** in the Player tab to hear playback through your device's speakers (great for practice when you're away from your organ).

Key Settings to Know

Setting	What It Does
Auto-Connect	Automatically reconnects to your last MIDI device
Record Velocity	Captures how hard you press keys (dynamics)
Transpose	Shifts playback pitch up or down by semitones
Default Tempo	Sets BPM for recordings (mainly for export purposes)
